Public Notice

Ref No.: TNMC/P.N 3 /2020 Dated: 27th August, 2020

It is brought to the notice of all concerned and public at large that recently the Board of Governors in Supersession of MCI has issued an Advisory regarding accepting of Internship of Foreign Medical Graduates in Ref No. MCI–203(1) (Gen.)/2020-Regn./12442 Dated 30.07.2020. In the above Advisory, attention of a Public Notice issued by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India was invited and stated as follows;

“General Public is hereby informed that the Internship training completed by an Indian National during his / her MBBS course in China was / is acceptable for the purpose of grant of permanent registration under section 13 (3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

It is not mandatory for such students to do 12month internship training in India.”

The Board of Governors in Supersession of Medical Council of India further stated that “it is in accordance with provisions of Indian Medical Council Act 1956 in respect of MBBS or equivalent primary qualification obtained by an Indian National from any other country also”

The matter was discussed at length by the Members of Tamil Nadu Medical Council.

The Council resolved that, that the Internship training completed by an Indian National during his / her MBBS or equivalent course in China or any other foreign country is acceptable for the purpose of grant of permanent registration under section 13 (3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 provided that

- i) The minimum duration of the course (excluding the period of study of local language) should be 4 ½ years**
- ii) Candidates should have not less than 75% attendance**
- iii) The duration of internship training is one year, done in the campus and not through online mode.**

Candidates who had completed part of their internship training in the campus and partly through online mode, the online mode of internship training will not be accepted. Such candidates should undergo internship training in India for the online period in "any of the Government Institutions' approved by the Medical council of India.

It is further resolved that, before accepting their internship the passport of such candidates should be verified to ensure the minimum duration of the course and 75% attendance and it is also to be ensured that the internship training is not through video conferencing.
